The data processing agreement with Microsoft Corporation states that Microsoft Corporation is entitled to engage additional sub-processors and replace existing sub-processors on special terms. 4. Click "Save to Library" at the top of the document list
5. Log in to your Microsoft account in the pop-up window
6. Click "Yes" to receive email notifications
7. Enter your email address and specify how often you wish to receive notifications
8. Click "Save"
